Safety Precautions (Be sure to observe)

- This guide indicates items that require particular caution to ensure safe use of the product. Be sure to read the guide prior to installation and handle the product properly.
- Safety precautions are categorized by the degree on hazard or damage that may result if the precaution is disregarded and the product is used improperly. Each category is represented by a symbol as shown below.



Warning

Installation Precautions (Read prior to installation.)



Warning

- Before installing the product check to make sure that the backing material is present. (If mounting brackets are required, purchase the required number separately.)
- The supplied bracket-mounting screws are screws that should be used for wood only.



Caution

- This product is designed for indoor use. Do not install it outdoors.
- Do not install the product where it will be exposed to high temperature or high humidity, or where it may be splashed with water.



Precautions on Use (Read prior to Use.)



Warning

- Do not hang anything on the product or hang on to it in order to avoid damage to the product and prevent it from falling off.



- Never operate the shade quickly or forcibly in order to avoid damage to the product and prevent it from falling off.



- Do not allow children to play with the operation cord, as the cord could present a risk of entanglement and accident.



Caution

- Be sure to close the windows or raise the shade in the event of strong winds.



- Never disassemble or apply lubricant to the moving parts in order to prevent damage and malfunction.

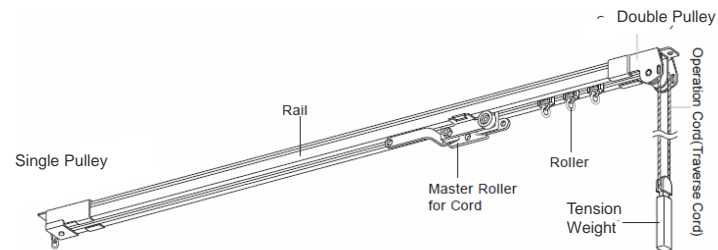


- Never place the product near a naked flame.



- Do not place any objects, especially fragile objects, in the path of the shade.

Numbers of Components

- Preinstalled parts on the rail

Rail	1pc *Product Width:100mm (single pulley side:50mm; double pulley side:50mm)
Roller	8 pcs/m *Measurement fractions should be rounded up.
Pulley Set	1 pair
Master Roller	1pc
Traverse Cord	Required Number
Tension Weight	1pc

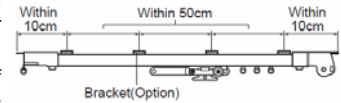
Fixing Screw (φ3.5×16) | 2 pcs



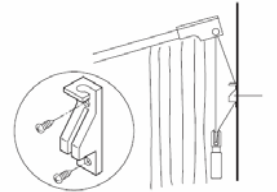
Cord Stopper

Installation

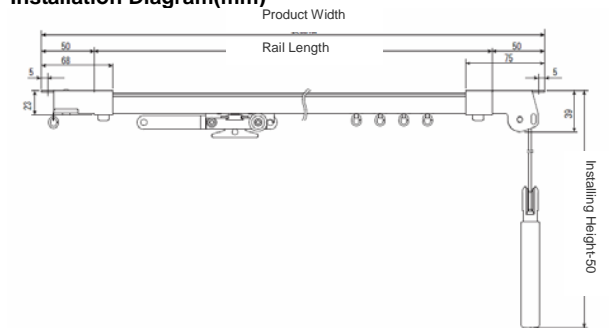
1. Install the rail set in the ceiling or wall. (If mounting brackets are required, purchase the necessary number separately.)
*Determine the mounting spacing of brackets using the illustration at right as a guide.



2. Install the cord stopper, which is designed to fasten the operation cord on the wall using the fixing screws supplied with the product.
*If the curtain is folded up, be sure to hook the operation cord on the cord stopper.

Maintenance

- Do not use a thinner or other chemical for cleaning, as they may discolor or deform the product.

- To clean the product, wipe it using a soft, dry clean cloth.
